1. Day nursery (Kindergarten) and the school system.
2. Bilingual education.
3. Children's rights.
4. Preventative healthcare.
5. Sexual education/development.
6. Motor skills (physical milestones).
7. Dealing with the media.
8. Healthy nutrition.
9. Prevention of addictions (drugs etc.).
10. Child safety - preventing accidents.
